## Instruction for foreign citizens to issue the visa in the consular office of the MFA of Russia

For issuing a single-entry, a tourist or a humanitarian visa for entry to the territory of the Russian Federation and exit you need to:

- 1) Receive an invitation for your name from Directorate of the World Combat Games 2013 in Saint-Petersburg.
- 2) Contact the consular office of the Ministry of Foreign Affairs of the Russian Federation personally for issuing the visa. For that you have to submit the following documents personally to the consular office of the Ministry of Foreign Affairs of the Russian Federation:

- **Invitation** for your name from Directorate of the World Combat Games-2013 in Saint-Petersburg;
- **Valid international passport.** The passport should have at least 2 blank pages meant for visas; its expiration date should not be later than 6 months after visa expiration date (April 27th, 2014).
- **A completed visa application form.** Visa form is filled in by the applicant legibly by hand or with the use of technical means in the official language of the country of the Russian Consulate, in Russian or in English. The answers to the questions should be exhaustive. The application is signed by the applicant personally.
- **2 photos with the size 3,5 x 4,5 cm (in color on the light whole-colored background)** with legible full-face picture without darkened eyeglasses and with no head-wear on (apart from the applicants for whom having a head-wear on is mandatory due to national identity or religious affiliation, and provided that the applicant is depicted in the same headwear on the passport photo);
- **Medical insurance**, valid on the territory of the Russian Federation;
- **A document confirming the payment** of the state duty or consulage and charge against the refund of the actual expenses (for issuing of the tourist, humanitarian or single-entry visa: **100 US dollars**).
